



- *Bell Tower window frame-Purchase and install a new bronze plaque, commemorating Bob and Lavada Cleis
- *Adapt bell tower doors to fit in New York Ave frame
- *Refinish Adams St doors and repair door closers and door lock
- *Refinish Breezeway doors
- *Install floor base trim inside Ohio Ave entrance
- *Insulate heat pipes inside Ohio Ave entrance
- *Paint and trim outside Ohio Ave entrance
- *Remove all scrap metal that has accumulated in the sanctuary boiler room
- *Remove one sanctuary boiler and install a new one
- *Sanctuary boiler room needs new outside door
- *Reinforce floor joists in old organ room loft
- *Finish Pastors bathroom
- *Install kitchenette in council room
- *Find entrance and fix leak and repair walls in council room
- *Determine problem with "Bladder" expansion tank in education building boiler room


