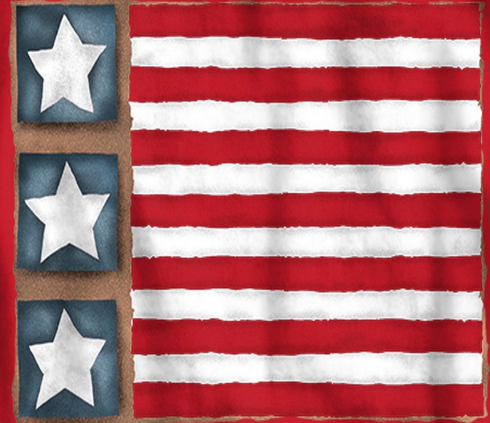

On January 30th, 2017, our lives changed forever. It started as any normal Monday until the police knocked on our door to deliver the tragic news that our son, Isaiah, had been fatally injured in a car accident on his way to work. Just 8 short months post-graduation.

Isaiah was just 19 years young. He became more than we could've ever imagined. Isaiah had a great job as a very accomplished fitter/welder at Hall Industries in Ellwood City. Isaiah was solidly on the path to success that he had worked so hard to achieve. Isaiah was an active, confirmed member of his church. He served 2 years in Beaver School Districts Army JROTC Program before enrolling in The Beaver County Career and Technology Centers 2-year Welding program. Isaiah was certified in multiple different welding processes and was an officer of The Beaver Valley Student Chapter of The American Welding Society. Isaiah always used to say: If you love what you do, you'll never work a day in your life! Isaiah played football from 4th grade through his senior year in high school. Isaiah was a letterman, captain, MAC AA Conference for the offensive line and winner of The New Brighton Football Sportsmanship of The Year Award his senior year. Isaiah had an immense love for football and was truly a Lion at heart. Isaiah was an avid rider, hunter and fisherman. Isaiah served his community through numerous community service projects and would always be willing to lend a helping hand to those in need.

Our family has given much thought as to how we can best honor Isaiah's memory; we decided a scholarship to help other young people reach their full potential would be a fitting Legacy. We will be specifically looking for applicants pursuing a career in the trades field but not limited to. The scholarship will not be based solely on academic merit. Consideration will be given to those students that exhibit outstanding personal qualities such as a solid work ethic, integrity, a positive attitude, and a strong desire to reach their goals. 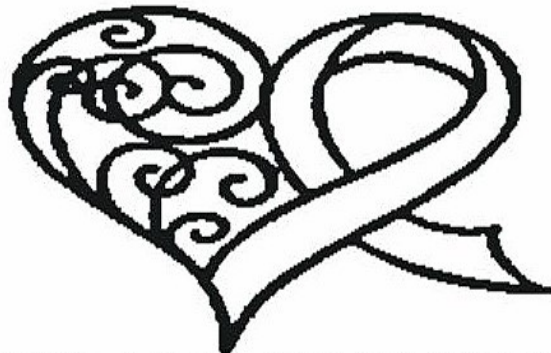

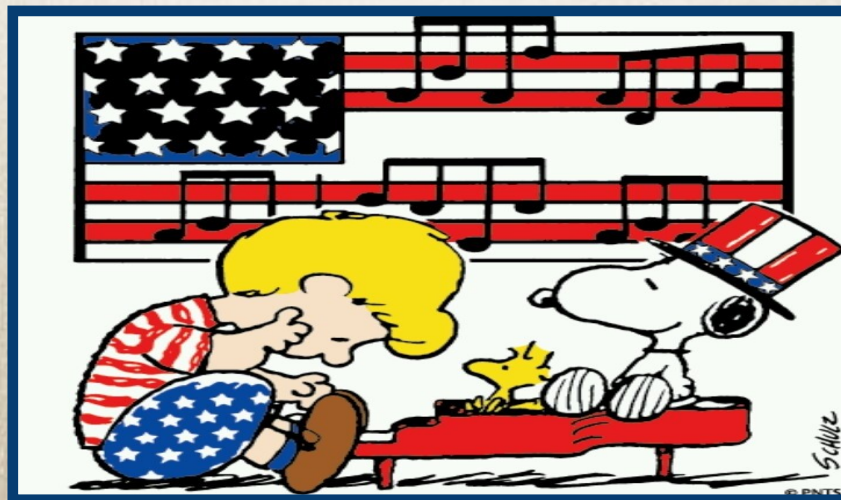

Dear Pastor Clagg and Congregation,

It is my pleasure to be reaching out to you today! As you may know I have almost completed my freshman year at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas; majoring in elementary education. My college experience has been very rewarding in a new environment, everlasting friendships, and a great support system. But by far, the most rewarding experience is being involved with Cru.

Cru is an interdenominational Christian movement on over 1,000 campuses in the U.S. and in 180 countries. Not only have I received training in biblical studies, but I have also gained training in how to share my faith with others. I am currently a member of a bible study with Cru on my campus that has led me to walk deeper in my faith with the Lord.



This summer I have a wonderful opportunity to go on a Cru summer mission to Barcelona, Spain. It is a 4-week long inner-city mission that involves ministering to those in need. While addressing people's physical and social needs, we will also be addressing people's ultimate need for Christ. We will be collaborating with Cru staff from Barcelona to serve and empower existing local churches and organizations. I'm excited about the long-term impact this summer will have and what I'll learn through this experience.



As a part of the summer mission, I am building a team of ministry partners who will join me in prayer and through giving financially. I will be raising \$4,500, which will cover the costs of transportation, room and board, and outreach expenses.
