


What do we know of Jewish history and Old Testament stories? We'll follow Zechariah and Elizabeth as their son arrives. Luke chapter 1.

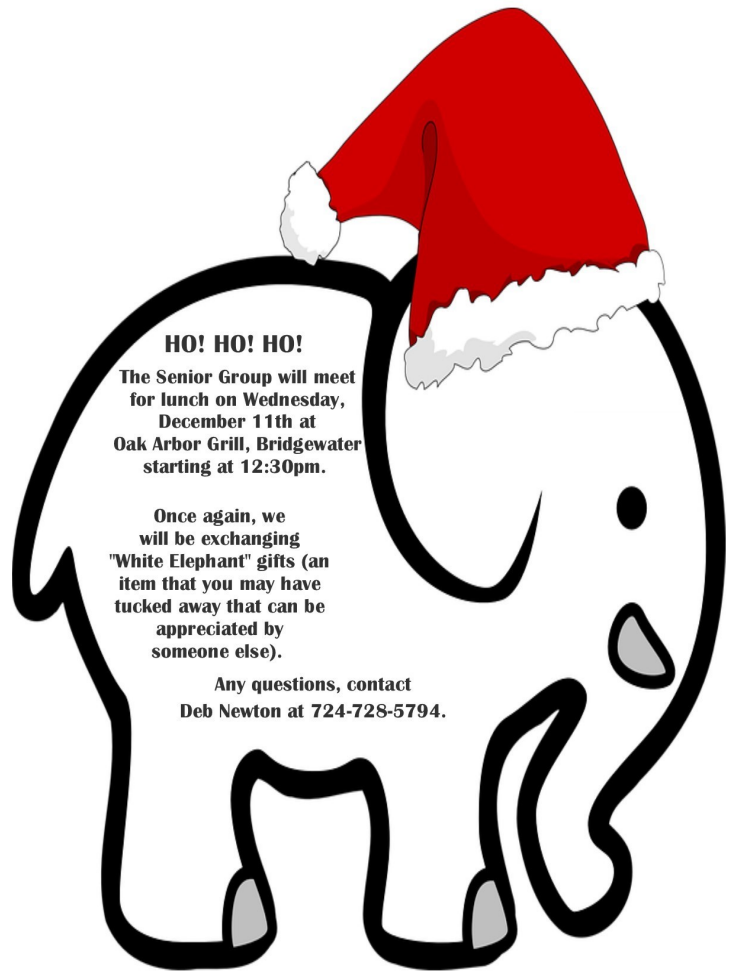
